We can still remember clearly how we departed from Holland, started our trip to Cambodia and arrived here with the 5 of us. Finally we were in the country where we had been 'traveling' to for so long...

So much has happened in the time that lies in between. We are here for 10 months now and the time has passed by very fast! But how do you summarise such a huge process in just a couple of sentences..?

During these months we, little by little, build up relations with the people around us and have tried to show them, just in everyday life, something about God who loves people so dearly. We did make our house a home and we've learned how and where to get the things that we need. We also learned some basic things about how things are done here, some of the 'do's' and 'don'ts'.

Yes, we are still very much in that process!

Soon after we arrived we have started learning the Khmer language. We then realised how much a language tells about a country! We did start with the help of a private tutor. She helped us with the first words and sentences and we are very thankful for that.

Because of that we were able to get around a bit and understand a bit. After that we started studying language and culture at [G2K](#). It is an encouraging thing to notice the progress. This is especially true when we have guests and when they feedback us about the 'abracadabra' that we are talking;-) Fun!

During the last months we were happy to receive guests. A special time for us and the children, but also for the visitors themselves. It surely is an experience that they all will take home with them.

WE HAVE MOVED

Last February we have moved to a more quiet part of Phnom Penh. What a blessing it is! We do enjoy this new place every day and it feels like a safe base to work from. During the move we did receive a lot of help from our friends and so we even managed to do it all in one day! Our 'tuk-tuk'-man did also offer his help to us together with his friends... His 'official' location is not here but we do have good contact, he is still available for us and he regularly takes us to where we want to go. Please pray for this contact.

We do live in a nice house, on the very top of a 'phteah I-veng', a typical Cambodian flat and we do feel at home here. This place helps us all. From the balcony of our house we do have a view over a part of the city. During the evenings we enjoy a 'cool' breeze that cools down the place a bit (to about 32 degrees celsius for example..).

We still live among the Khmer people, we do have contact with them every day, but it is much more quiet and the kids do have a place to run and play and there are other local kids to play with! We can enjoy a bit of football or badminton. They enjoy it!

This house truly is a prayer-item that is granted. We also have good contact with the house owner and are getting to know more and more people in the block. Please pray for them.
