Almost holidays...

Are you also counting down? As I write this, for us it is only 7 days left, and then we will be off: holiday! When we look back at what happened over the past period, we enter that holiday tired, but very grateful. Grab a cup of coffee, read on and be encouraged.

The past few months were marked by many new developments: the online training, a real Alongsiders app(!), a week of recording videos so that we can easily bring content closer to young people. Together with others, a lot of work has been done. And then you would forget that of course, that is not what it is all about...

All these things are just tools - instruments that we can use. The real point is to help young people to be disciples of the Lord Jesus and in turn to make disciples of Him. That is the great

commission, those were Jesus' last words, and that is what we want to put into practice. Later in this newsletter we will share more testimonies, but let me introduce you to Amy (not 'our' Amy, but Alongsiders Amy).

Amy became an Alongsider through a project that we did together with Alpha Youth. Great, because in that way about 35 Alongsiders joined.

Amy and her younger sister work together. They use the Alongsiders app and have started with the challenges. Or to be more specific, they started with the challenge "Secret Bless". Shortly after starting it, we were asked, "Why do you bless anyway?" "Where does Jesus call us to do that?"

We shared about how Jesus blessed children, broke bread and fed thousands, touched untouchables - all acts of blessing and blessing. Amy understood. Shortly after, we contacted her to hear her

story. Amy shared that every Monday morning when she goes to school, she watches the videos in the app, prays and discusses with her 'younger sister' how they can bless people in Jesus name that day. Classmates, teachers, friends, people at home. Wonderful, isn't it?

The tools help the Alongsiders, and that is how they are meant to be. Because what we want and desire is that young people - like Amy - in obedience to Jesus reach out to others. That they pass on what they have found in the Lord Jesus. By reaching out to others, we ourselves grow.

It was Jesus who said: "It is enough for a disciple to become like the Master" - and that is exactly what we want. To grow together in the image of the Master, so that when others look at us they will see more and more of Him. "He must become greater, I less."
