Lights out, sound on and 'of we go'. It was only a few days ago that we watched the documentary about Johan Toet's life with a whole group of people in Almere. Impressive - that was the word I often heard after the film.

## And it wasn't just about the film...

The roller coaster that the film takes you on is difficult to put into words. How do you describe the life of a young man who wants to prove himself because his father has always rejected him, a young man who looks for it in drugs, has money like water, but is empty inside? A man who has made it all up, but is eventually caught in Portugal and ends up in prison?

But then - and in the film you see the emotions on Johan's face - Jesus appears in his cell. A moment that changes everything...

On the 14th of March - exactly 2 months earlier - Micha and I were watching the premiere of this movie in the cinema in Utrecht.

It was Micha's birthday and we had a great moment together. The film touched us both and I thought: more people should see this - how can we show this in Almere? And after a lot of work and organisation, that was it. Less of me' - that is the message of the film. Less Johan Toet, less Mart-Jan and Talitha van der Maas and less you.

But more of the Lord Jesus, more of sharing and living the gospel. It is, as it were, the echo we have heard from the mouth of John for centuries. Impressive.

That same afternoon, we sat down with a group of young people to think about Alongsiders. Each of these young people has a younger brother or sister and we met to share a piece of life. To receive training and inspiration, to encourage

each other. Because that is what we need so much. The process of 'less of me' is going on in all of us and we need that arm of the other around our shoulder. It doesn't work on its own. Precious moments

We finished with a meal, a moment of prayer in pairs and a beautiful song about how we may be the hands and feet of Jesus together, how we may bring His name. That is the deep desire of Alongsiders.

At the end of such a full and busy day, Talitha and I say to each other: "This is what we are made for, to go out and follow Jesus together.

Thank you for walking with us, praying with us, supporting us. Our prayer: less us - more of Jesus.

At the same time we notice that especially Micha is having a hard time. The school system in which he finds himself seems to fit him only with difficulty and Micha is not flourishing. Together with some people we are looking for a school situation that is appropriate and where Micah, with all his qualities, can flourish, grow and

enjoy. Would you like to pray for him with us?

Amy has had a difficult time as well - and still is, although she is doing better. There have been many changes at school and Amy's class has quite some challenges.

Sometimes Amy runs into herself - a growth opportunity, but that is sometimes not easy.

Of course we cannot write everything about Micah and Amy in a newsletter, but your prayers are very welcome.

Joy is doing well. We just wrote about her musical talents, school is going very well and it is nice to see how she - and Amy and Micha too - are busy with the Lord and how that has an impact on who she is.
